2.8 Resolution for transfer of funds from Fund 3 to Fund 5

b. Staff Update: CCBE, CCBF, SI, SVI, Academic, Francisation

- CCBE: status quo from Fall 9 day and evening classes opened
- Academics: 2 teachers (4 classes) opened
- Francization will continue (4 day and 5 evening classes opened)
- Special Needs: status quo

c. Update on Francization Program

- The EMSB has opted to continue with this program
- BUT not accepting new students or transfers from other centers
- Only registered current students

d. New SI Tutor

- Since more funding from Ministry of Education was granted, Manny has taken this tutor role (Master's degree, behavioral tech and crisis intervention experience)
- e. Update on Renovation Projects: Mesure P-2107 Kitchen
- There's hope! Some electricians at work! New Goal for kitchen: January

f. Update on Emergency Preparedness—Fire Drill, Lock Down, Code Silver

- A lockdown and a code silver drill were successfully completed another will be held in January, followed by another Fire drill in the Spring
- Emergency preparedness binder: We have updated our procedures (tornados, earthquakes, etc.) and teachers have been assigned to help update emergency kit protocol binder

g. School activities: November & December

- November Remembrance Day: students from all departments read 'In Flanders Fields' in both English and French on the intercom; students wrote postcards to veterans which were then delivered
- Constable Anne-Marie Gauvreau from SPVM Montreal North Community Relations held sessions
 on safe and developing relationships for SI; fraud, dating & internet for Francization, and Alcohol
 & drug use and new drivers' license for Academics

h. Special Olympics Quebec at Galileo – Bocce – November 28

- 30 students in SI department, who have practiced every Wednesday, will have a Bocce Tournament on November 28 at Leonardo da Vinci Centre. They practiced with coordinators Tanya, Luciana and Lisa G., as well as two fathers from the community
- i. Autism Karate at Galileo Last day on December 12
- 65 students are currently participating in Karate every Thursday for a 10-week program ending on December 12
- j. Les Grands Ballet Canadiens de Montreal January 8 to March 26, 2025
- 25.00\$ cost for students (school pays part and is also subsidized)
- 10-week program
- k. Other activities: Biodome for SI students (123 students attended); Recognition awards for Academic students and a lunch; Seed Bomb workshop from City of Montreal North holding 2 workshops (both English and French) in November; EMSB Toy Drive Galileo Adult Centre collecting toys
